LEADERSHIP BIOGRAPHY



Christina Bruning, a vibrant social entrepreneur, is one of the 21 Leaders for the 21st Century recognized by Women's eNews for stretching her reach across cultures. With 25 years of leadership in operations, IT, and project management, Christina is a dynamic business and civic leader. She is an expert in citizen diplomacy and socially innovative education programs. Christina has managed culturally diverse relationships with government, fortune 500 companies, emerging businesses, private foundations, non-profits, and educational institutions in more than 20 countries.

Ms Bruning has served the community as the Global Networking Chair for the Center for Women & Democracy (CWD), a board member of Women's eNews, the Washington State coordinator for the Partners of Americas Youth Ambassador Program, President of Women's Business Exchange, and leadership council member for the Northwest Girls Coalition. She builds a strong sense of community through civic engagement, is a recipient of the Kiwanis Everyday Hero award and the City of Vilnius Lithuania Mayoral Award. As a citizen advocate, Christina initiated social programs for families in need, strategically led a group of residents to positively affect city policy, and oversaw the reconstruction of fourteen homes devastated by flooding.

Christina conveys a broad based international perspective locally, nationally, and globally. She is the founder of AC, a business and cultural exchange with a focus on human rights, access to information, economic equity, and cultural experience, enhancing the leadership potential of enterprising youth, non-profit and government leaders, executives, and entrepreneurs. Christina participated in the CWD Women's Mission to Sweden and the Baltic States, South Africa, and led the development of the Mission to Chile. Bruning participated in the U.S. Business Investment and Trade Mission to the Baltic States, led a multi-national delegation to Egypt, Turkey, and France for the Global Summit of Women, spearheaded Innovation: Policy, Science and Technology a study trip focusing on entrepreneurship education and technology transfer in the U.S. for Lithuanian ministry officials and industry leaders, and is leading the Lithuanian Youth Leaders program. Christina collaborated with the Kazickas Family Foundation, Internews Network, and the International Women's Media Foundation on a Leadership Institute for journalists from the former Soviet Republics. As a catalyst for the 5th Biennial Eastern Europe/Central Asia Breast Cancer Education, Outreach and Advocacy Summit, Christina partnered with Seattle Cancer Care Alliance and Nedelsk - Do Not Delay and included a multi-day Oncology Exchange; subsequently developed Medicine: Policy, Science & Technology program featuring Women's Health and Oncology for Lithuanian medical students. She has facilitated international trainings for State Department program alumni in the far east of Russia, was a speaker at Women of the World in St. Lucia, and is a requested speaker for local and international events. Christina is a professional host for the Foundation for Russian American Economic Cooperation, Issaquah Sister Cities Morocco, and Seattle World Affairs Council.

Ms Bruning worked for Nordstrom and Weyerhaeuser in an IT leadership capacity and as the Manager of Project Management for the US Library Program of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Christina led a team to achieve the Foundation's US Library Program objectives, a five-year, \$250 million investment in public libraries throughout the United States, providing approximately 47,000 computers in 11,000 buildings, 62,000 training opportunities, internet connections, and support to increase access to digital information and software tools for underserved populations.

She enjoys traveling, exploring the outdoors, hiking, and cycling.
